Discuss Death in the Downline

Review the following questions to get some conversation about Death in the Downline started.

- 1. Death in the Downline dives into the strange world of multi-level marketing, or "MLMs". What is your personal experience with MLMs? Have you known someone who was part of one, or watched any of the documentaries about them, such as LuLaRich or Betting on Zero?
- 2. Some of the over-the-top moments in the book (like the LuminSANITY conference) are based on real aspects of various MLM companies. Were there any moments that surprised you, or prompted you to do your own research?
- 3. Drew gets involved in LuminUS partially because of economic precarity. What are some other reasons someone might get involved in an MLM?
- 4. The LuminUS Ladies are selling a lifestyle as much as a product, showing off expensive cars and perfect houses while some of them are secretly drowning in debt. What about our culture encourages this kind of behavior? Do you think social media is to blame?

- 5. Do you empathize with Steph's position, or do you feel like she is guilty in LuminUS' damage to the people in her downline?
- 6. Steph's husband calls LuminUS a cult. Do you think that MLMs can reach cult status?
- 7. The book explores several complicated relationship dynamics. What do you think it has to say about female friendship? About the power dynamics between spouses?
- 8. Were you surprised when the real murderer was revealed?
